Regular Meetings: 1st and 3rd Thursday, August, September, October

Swarna has reserved the clubhouse at Lake Louise Apts. for general meetings for the following Thursdays:

8/24 9/7 9/21 10/5 10/19 9/2.

The facility will work very nicely for us. It has the following features:

- 1. a refrigerator in case we wish to serve refreshments
- 2. a drinking fountain for water
- 3. folding tables
- 4. sofas and chairs to seat about 70
- 5. plenty of floor space to sit on if more than 70 people attend
- 6. a nice swimming pool to mingle around
- 7. plenty of parking
- 8. It's Free!

One negative feature: Lake Louise entrance is gated. Georgians for a Green White House will have to type the code "1515" on the keypad to enter. First press "*" and "0" buttons <u>simultaneously</u>. Then press "1515". Swarna will tape the following instructions to the keypad to facilitate entry:

Green Party guests and members,

Press "*" and "0" simultaneously. Then let go and press your special four-digit code one digit at a time. If you have trouble with the code, park your car in the driveway next to a curb. Then walk through the pedestrian gate on the left.

After you get past the gate, turn left. The clubhouse is the 4th building on the right (the only one-story building you will see). Park in any space which is not directly in front of a building.

Directions to the clubhouse will also be taped to the pedestrian gate for those who arrive by Marta or bike.

The gate may not create a big problem. The worst case scenario is that a person will not know the 4-digit code and will have to park outside the gate, where there is plenty of room for cars, and walk to the clubhouse, which is not a long walk. Another option is for someone to stand by the gate and sweep a gate card by the reader to permit Greens to enter. Directions to Lake Louise are as follows:

Directions from I-285 at Georgia 400:

Go east no I-285. Just after Buford Highway exit two more right lanes open up. Get into the far right lane. As you approach I-85 the sign above this lane reads "Chamblee-Tucker Road." Stay in this lane and go straight. Do not fork to the right to get on the I-85 North ramp. The Chamblee-Tucker lane will become an off-ramp and end at a traffic light. At the light turn left. You will cross over I-285. Turn right at the 3rd traffic light. This will be Henderson Mill Road. About ¹/₂ mile later you will see Lake Louise Apartments on the left. If you go under the I-285 overpass, you have gone too far.

Directions from I-285 at Lavista:

Go north on I-285. Stay in the right lane. Go straight instead of forking right when it branches to connect with I-85. There is an overhead sign labeled "Chamblee-Tucker Road Exit Only" where this fork occurs. The lane ends at a traffic light. Turn right. Then turn right at the 2nd traffic light. This will be Henderson Mill Road. About ¹/₂ mile later you will see Lake Louise Apartments on the left. If you go under the I-285 overpass, you have gone too far.

Directions from Downtown Connector:

Go north on I-85. Just after the Chamblee-Tucker Road exit, a new right lane is created. Get into this lane. Stay in the very right lane. It will become the off ramp for Chamblee-Tucker Road. At the traffic light located at the end of the ramp, turn left. You will cross over I-285. Turn right at the 3rd traffic light. This will be Henderson Mill Road. About ¹/₂ mile later you will see Lake Louise Apartments on the left. If you go under the I-285 overpass, you have gone too far.

Directions from I-85 at Jimmy Carter:

Go south on I-85. Take the I-285 East exit. Stay in the right lane as the ramp curves up and over other ramps. Move right into the Chamblee-Tucker Road exit lane. It ends at Chamblee-Tucker Road. Turn left at the light. Turn right at the 3rd traffic light. This will be Henderson Mill Road. About ¹/₂ mile later you will see Lake Louise Apartments on the left. If you go under the I-285 overpass, you have gone too far.
